St. Vincent de Paul Society Report

Our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society concluded the fiscal year at the end of September and started a new one on October 1st.

We made 140 phone/home visits, helping 233 individuals and families. Your financial contributions helped 193 adults and 233 children in our neighborhood. Our treasure's end of the year report follows below and gives the specifics.

TOTAL REVENUE for the fiscal year was \$25,696:

- \$14,748 from church members
- \$ 1,827 from SVdP members
- \$ 5,280 from other SVdP conferences, mainly Immaculate Conception, Holy Spirit, and St. Joseph. (We share the cost of help for families that are between us and neighboring parishes.)
- \$ 3,841 from bequests and other sources.

TOTAL EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR: \$22,836

- \$ 580 Motels
- \$ 12,610 Rent
- \$ 7,543 Utilities
- \$ 846 Beds
- \$ 810 Gift Cards to Smart and Final for Food
- \$ 447 Other.
