Why is the Parish Office Closed until December 22ND?

Early this past week Fr. Wayne was exposed to COVID-19 and after consultation with his Physician and the Chancellor of the Diocese of Victoria he will be quarantined until December 22nd. This means the parish office will be closed until December 22nd. Fr. Wayne will celebrate daily Masses alone in the rectory during this time. Weekend Masses will be celebrated in St. Michael Church at the normal times by visiting priests. There will be **No Masses at 9am on Sundays in Dubina** on December 13th and 20th. ALL Christmas Masses will be celebrated as noted above as far as will be possible!!!

As of Friday, December 11, at 4:00pm Fr. Wayne has no COVID symptoms! At the advice of his physician he will be tested for COVID on December 16th in preparation for returning to public ministry on December 22nd. In the meantime you may drop off notes/information/etc. in the mailbox at the rectory entrance or leave messages on the answering machine.
