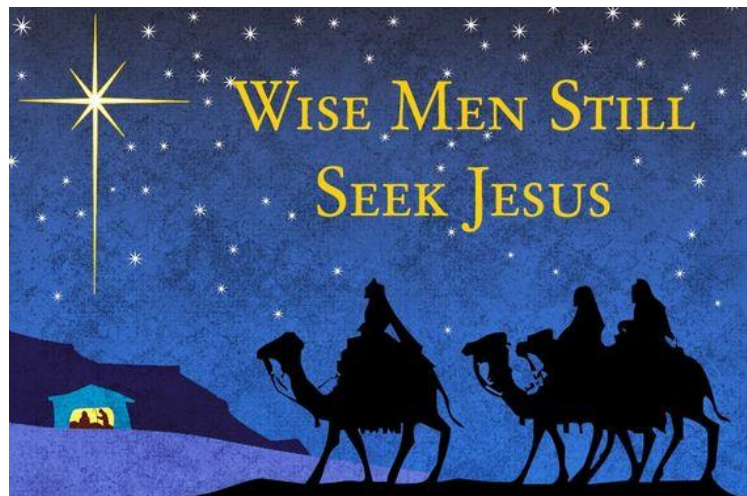
FINDING GOD

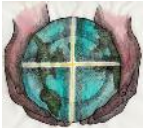
