MAID LEGISLATION SURVEY

Recently, the Government of Canada announced an online survey of Canadians' views on medically-assisted suicide. The two-week period of consultation **ends tomorrow Monday, January 27!** The survey is predicated on the assumption that respondents support euthanasia legislation. Even so, the survey does have text boxes that afford the opportunity to let the government know that you are against medically assisted death. 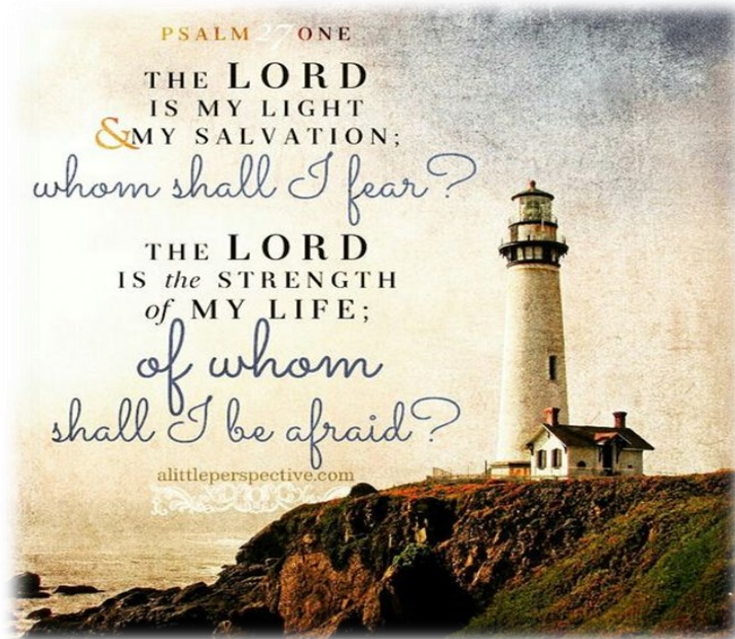
