March 18<sup>th</sup> - The Importance of Discernment

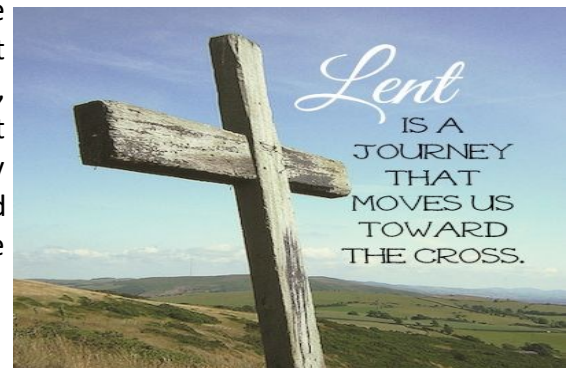
