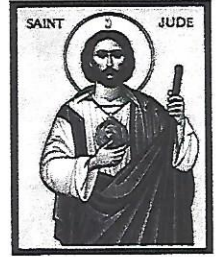

DEAR PARISH...

On my initiative as your pastor I have committed St. Jude's with the full and unanimous approval of both the Finance committee and the Parish Council to make a monetary gift to Holy Trinity Parish in a time of need.

Christian charity is often understood as aid to needy individuals or worthy institutions. But it is also appropriate that when we are aware of the struggles of our neighboring sister parishes to not only pray for them and wish them well, but to seek a way to share our service and treasure with them. We are in a unique position to do so.

Because we receive a monthly rental income in excess of \$8600 from the YWCA, our finances are very robust, robust even beyond our expenses. I have given to our sister parish a one-time gift of \$25,000. This is the near equivalent of three months rent from our school building. Our parish will still accrue three times this amount year from the rents.

Let me be clear. One. **No** monies that you give or have given to St. Jude will be expended in this gift and never will. Two. This is a one-time gift and carries neither obligation nor expectation that we will do this again. Three. This action was approved by the Archdiocese.

I hope that you will all support this action I took in your name. The support of the work of the Church and its people is a tradition that began from our earliest days in the collection made by St. Paul and St. Barnabas from the parishes of the province of Asia to support the church of Jerusalem (1 Cor 16). We do well to follow their example. I am willing to answer all your questions and welcome all concerns.
