OPENING OF THE MASS BOOK—2019

It is a spiritual work of Mercy to pray for the repose of the Faithful Departed. May the Lord continue to bless us as we present our loved ones to the Lord for the blessing of eternal life.

This year the Mass Book will be opened from October 13th through November 30th

This is the time of year that we "open" our Mass Intention Book, enabling you to reserve a specific date or dates for the celebration of a Mass for your special memorials like anniversaries of a birth or death of loved ones, marriages, or special times and gratitude for events of our lives.

The Intention(s) will be for Masses celebrated from January 1 until December 31, 2019.

The Stipend is \$5.00 for each specific request. If you will be having a Mass Intention for a person whom has died, please put a cross (+) after the name. If you have having a Mass said for a person whom is living, it will be listed in the Mass Book as "For the well being of (name)."

Reservations will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis or scheduled for the closest date, and please remember that weekday Masses at St. Jude are offered on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. You may choose any Saturday Mass, but Sunday Mass is commonly said "For The People of St. Jude Parish".

Please put your Mass Intentions in the collection basket or on the table with the Prayer Intention Box on any time through November 30th in an envelope marked "Mass Book." What a special way to honor and remember the souls of those who have gone before us and the spirit of those who are with us today.

This October through early November our Service Commission will be taking a collection to be delivered to our veterans for Veteran's Day. Below is a list of items needed given to us by Jefferson Barracks:

Refreshments: Sugar-free candy, cookies and snacks in single serving original store packaging, coffee - must be unopened. Men's undershirts, socks, underwear and boxers (new only) (size M to 3 XL).

Ladies underwear and sports bras (new only).

NEW only clothing items (size M to 3 XL) and new shoes: Blue jeans, long sleeve & short sleeve shirts, sneakers, non-skid scuffs/slippers, Sweatshirts and Sweatpants, Soft to the touch material Lap Robes, men and women swimsuits, gloves, stocking hats, scarves, belts (men's and women's).

Winter coats and jackets of all sizes (new or these can be Gently Used)

Suitcases, backpacks and duffle bags.

Personal hygiene products (deodorant - men's and women's, wide tooth combs picks and brushes, toothbrushes - individual wrapped, toothpaste, denture adhesive, denture cleanser, disposable razors, shave cream, shampoo, flip-flops/shower shoes, reading glasses - all strengths, chap stick, lotion, feminine hygiene products) in original store packaging.
