Dynamic Catholic, *Alive!* - In the Gospel reading today, we hear how Jesus went off alone in the desert for 40 days to pray and fast. Jesus stayed in a personal relationship with His Father and He trusted that His Father would be with Him throughout all of His tribulation. We, like Jesus, need to maintain our personal relationship with God and remember as Paul shared in his letter to the Romans, "(God) enriches all who call upon Him."
