### March 17: Second Sunday of Lent - Listen

The Apostles actually hear God speak to them in today's Gospel. The exciting part for us is that God's message is not just for the Apostles. It is for each and everyone of us as well. We have been instructed by God, "This is My chosen Son, listen to Him." This was not framed in the form of a request. This was an instruction. Most of us have difficulty hearing Jesus' voice, and many would ask, "How do I even do that?" We will never hear the voice of Jesus if we don't listen for it or if we do all the talking during our prayer time. Prayer is meant to be a conversation and in a conversation we are challenged to balance the amount of time we speak with the amount of time we listen. The easiest way to hear Jesus speak to us is through the Scriptures, but we can also hear Him through others, through creation, through music, etc. The most important part of this is the actual listening. "Jesus, during this Lenten journey please help us to open our hearts and minds so that we can hear Your voice and listen to what You are saying to us. Then please give us the courage to follow any directions you give us. Amen."
