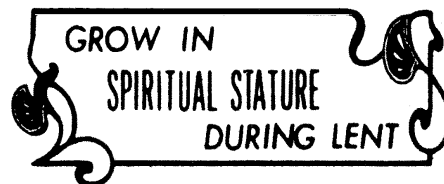
Do you have time for Jesus today?
