### Bridge Bread in another organization that we help through our Onhaweem Commission

We started selling Bridge Bread at St Jude in March 2017. Bridge Bread is sold through 33 churches. This year sales totaled \$29,966. 11 Catholic Parishes - sales and donations \$17,943 and 22 Protestant Churches - sales and donations \$12,022. They also have 4 commercial accounts (restaurant, hotel, food truck) sales total \$8,570, 1 institution (hospital) sales and donations \$526, 2 retail (shop and food truck) sales and donation \$5,672, and 3 other donors have donated \$5,576 Total income so far this year is \$50,310.93
