MASS INTENTIONS - NOVEMBER MEANS REMEMBER

The Mass Intention book is "open" this year from now through December 1st, 2020.

During November you may reserve specific dates throughout 2021 for the celebration of a Mass for special memorials; anniversaries of the death or birth or the well being of a loved one, marriages, or special times and gratitude for events in your life.

These Intention(s) will be for Masses celebrated from January 1st until December 31st, 2021. The stipend for each specific request is \$5.00. Please put your Mass Intentions in the collection basket in an envelope marked "Mass Book" any time through December 1st.

If the Mass Intention is for a person who has died, please put a cross (+) after the name. If you have a Mass said for a person who is living, please mark it for the "Well being of ___(name)___".

Reservations will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis or scheduled for the closest date. You may choose any Saturday Mass, but Sunday Mass is commonly offered: "For The People of St. Jude".

Special Mass Intentions are an excellent way to honor and remember the souls of those who have died and the spirit of those who are with us today.
