Re: CURRENT UPDATE

I WANT TO PROVIDE A SHORT UPDATE REGARDING WHERE WE ARE AND WHERE WE ARE HEADED. FIRST, HOWEVER, LET ME THANK ALL OF YOU FOR YOUR CONTINUED SUPPORT BOTH FINANCIALLY AND WITH OTHER VOLUNTEER EFFORTS. WE COULD NOT HAVE MADE IT THROUGH THESE TIMES WITHOUT YOUR SUPPORT. THAT DOES NOT MEAN THE PANDEMIC IS OVER.

DURING THIS PAST YEAR, WE HAVE SHELTERED OUR CLIENTS 24/7 IN OUR DAY SITE IN BRIDGETON. HAPPY TO REPORT OF NO COVID CASES DURING THAT TIME. WE DO NOT ACCEPT ANY NEW CLIENTS UNLESS THEY HAVE A CURRENT COVID TEST THAT IS NEGATIVE. IF NOT, WE SEND THEM FOR A TEST, AND HOUSE THEM IN A MOTEL UNTIL TEST RESULTS ARE FINAL. IF NEGATIVE, THE CLIENT/FAMILY WILL THEN MOVE INTO OUR SHELTER. WE NO LONGER HAVE THE CLIENTS SLEEP TOGETHER IN OUR LARGE KETTLER HALL. EACH CLIENT/FAMILY HAS AN EMPTY OFFICE THAT IS A PRIVATE ROOM.

THANKS TO OUR BRIDGETON LANDFILL GRANT, WE ARE ABLE TO COUNSEL OUR CLIENTS PROFESSIONALLY WITH LICENSED THERAPISTS FROM ST. LOUIS COUNSING, GREAT CIRCLE, AND A PRIVATE COUNSELOR WHO COMES ONSITE TWICE A WEEK. WE ARE SEEING GREAT PROGRESS IN OUR CLIENTS AS THEY RECEIVE THIS ASSISTANCE.

WHEN DO WE GO BACK TO THE NIGHT SITE MODEL? I AM NOT SURE. AS MORE PEOPLE ARE VACCINATED AND RESTRICTIONS ADJUSTED, SOME OF OUR CONGREGATIONS WILL OPEN. IF YOUR CONGREGATION IS GETTING CLOSE TO RE-OPENING, PLEASE LET CINDY OR ME KNOW SO WE CAN PLAN ACCORDINGLY. WE WILL CONTINUE OUR 24/7 MODEL UNTIL IT IS SAFE TO RETURN TO THE NIGHTSITE MODEL. PLEASE CALL ME WITH ANY QUESTIONS. (314) 209-9198

OUR NEEDS REMAIN THE SAME AS FAR AS FINANCIAL AND VOLUNTEER SUPPORT. WE LOOK FOR VOLUNTEER DRIVERS TO TAKE OUR CHILDREN TO AND FROM HEADSTART; OUR CLIENTS TO AND FROM APPOINTMENTS. WE NEED VOLUNTEERS TO READ TO OUR CHILDREN AND TO TUTOR OUR CHILDREN. ALWAYS CAN USE ASSISTANCE TO HELP MAKE OUR LANDSCAPE MORE APPEALING. I HOPE YOU ARE ENJOYING OUR NEW LOGO AND OUR NEW SIGN IF YOU DRIVE BY OUR BUILDING.

WHEN WE HAVE A "NORMAL" WE ARE PLANNING TO HAVE A 'VOLUNTEER APPRECIATION' EVENT TO RECOGNIZE THE CONTINUED SUPPORT OF ALL OF OUR VOLUNTEERS AND TO RECOGNIZE THOSE CONGREGATIONS THAT HAVE BEEN WITH US FOR 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, AND 30 YEARS!! WE CAN NEVER THANK YOU ENOUGH FOR ALL YOU DO.
