SAFETY MEASURES

- There is one entrance and one exit. Enter through the gate in front of the church along Metairie Road and exit between the playset and the back of the parish center.
- Temperatures will be taken upon entry.
- Color-coded wristbands will be provided upon entry, identifying time slots.
- Masks are required (ages 8 & up) if costume does not cover the mouth and nose.
- The school’s COVID waiver includes school events, including Trunk-or-Treat.
- One-way traffic flow (taped down, with X’s marking recommended social distance) guides trunk-or-treaters through the event.
- Children must be accompanied by their parent/guardian at all times.
