Corpus Christi: In 1213 AD, a German priest, Peter of Prague went on a pilgrimage to Rome. He stopped and celebrated Mass at Bolsena, Italy. What began as a normal liturgy took a miraculous turn. When he raised the host, he had just consecrated, real blood began to grackle from the host over his hands and onto the altar cloth. After a year of investigation and the miracle confirmed, the bloodstained corporal was brought to the church orvieto where Pope Urban IV was living at that time. Pope Urban IV instituted the Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus – or Corpus Christi, a year after the miracle. (Deacon Roger)
