****RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEWS****

Please remember to register or re-register your children for **Religious Education Classes**, contact Donna Wilson at 508-883-8794 or religiouseducation@staugustinesmillville.com. Your family must be **registered parishioners** at St. Augustine 's in Millville or Good Shepherd, Linwood to register your children in our Religious Education program. For children who are new to the program, a copy of his/her baptismal certificate is **required at the time of registration**. I would greatly appreciate hearing from each family as soon as possible so that we can be ready for all our students in just a few short weeks.

Please note there is a change in the schedule for students in GRADES 6-8. Due to the rotating schedule for the Confirmation students, this year we have decided to separate the middle school students to a time all to themselves. We will be able to focus on providing our attention to them. All students grades 6-8 will be dismissed from Mass with a special blessing to attend class, 11:30-1:00 every other weekend.

With the combining of resources between St. Augustine and Good Shepherd, we will be combining efforts for most retreats and sacramental preparation. This year the fees are \$75/1 child, \$90/2 children; \$115/3 or more children. If you send your payment in the offertory basket, please place it in an envelope clearly marked **Religious Education**. If you have any questions, please contact Donna Wilson at the email address above or leave a message at the Religious Education office, 508-883-8794. I will return your call as soon as possible.

Classes begin September 17, 2017 for all age groups. Kingdom Kids begin in the 10:30 Mass and parents pick up the children after Mass. **Grades 1-5** meet at 9:20-10:20 then join in the celebration of Mass at 10:30. **Grades 6-8** start at the celebration of Mass at 10:30 then are dismissed to class at 11:30-1:00 every other weekend. **Confirmation I & II** will celebrate Mass at 5pm followed by class at 6-7:30 at St. Augustine on September 17th, October 1st, and December 3rd. **Confirmation I** will also meet at St. Augustine at 6-7:30 on October 15th, November 19th, and December 19th.
