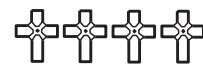

Mass Intentions and the Sanctuary Candle stipends are still only \$10.00 each.

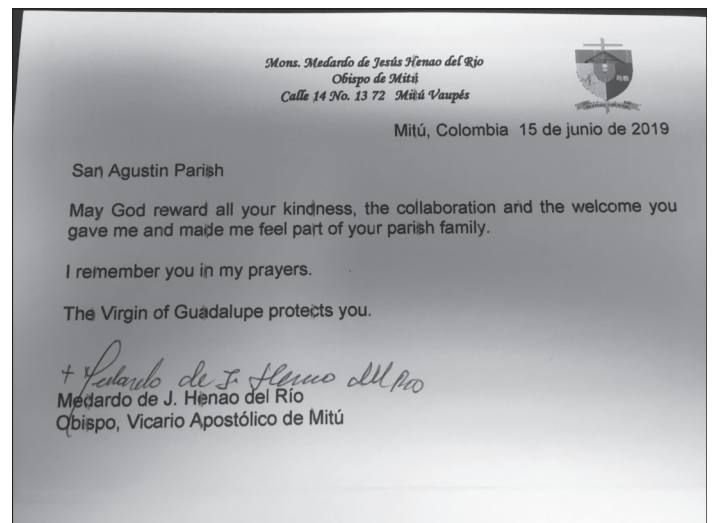
