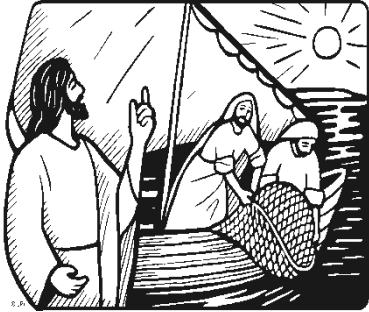




**Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, January 21, 2018**
