LITURGICAL REFLECTION FOR THE 2ND SUNDAY OF EASTER (April 8)

We stand with Thomas today to make one of the greatest professions of faith in scripture to *Jesus Christ, “My Lord, and my God!”* Thomas comes face to face with the *Risen Christ*. The celebration of the Christian funeral brings hope and consolation to the living. When a Christian dies we proclaim the Gospel of *Jesus Christ* with certainty and witness to Christian hope in the resurrection. The funeral rites recall God’s mercy and judgment and meet the human need to turn always to *God* in times of crisis. Death has lost its power. We live in the mercy of *God*, in the risen life of the *Easter Jesus*.
