### **LITURGICAL REFLECTION FOR THE 3<sup>rd</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER (April 15)**

In today’s Gospel, the Risen One appears with the greeting, *“Peace be with you!”* The Easter Jesus eats with the disciples in the upper room. At a funeral Mass, the community turns for spiritual nourishment to the table of the Eucharist. When a brother or sister dies, we gather to be nourished with the Bread of Life. In partaking of the Body of Christ, all are given a foretaste of eternal life in the Risen Lord. The priest with the community offers to the Father the sacrifice of the New Covenant and shares in the one bread and the one cup.
