### ***Liturgical Reflection for the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter (April 29)***

Jesus is the vine and we are the branches. When a grieving family stands graveside for the committal prayers of the Church, the concluding prayer reminds us that all life rests in Christ, the true vine of life. The prayer echoes the faith of believers: “Almighty God, through the death of Your Son on the cross, You destroyed our death; through His rest in the tomb, You hallowed the graves of all who believe in You; and through His rising again, You restored us to eternal life.” The crucified, buried, and risen Christ is our source of life. We are the branches of the sacred vine. Therein is our life.
