It is true that Christ will raise us up on the last day, but it is also true that, in a certain way, we have already risen with Christ in the Sacrament of Baptism. Because of Christ, Christian death has a positive meaning. By death, the soul is separated from the body, but when the Lord comes in all His Glory, He will give incorruptible life to our body, transformed by reunion with our soul.
