**CLERGY APPRECIATION DAY IS SUNDAY, OCTOBER 14** – Priest Appreciation Day began with the establishment of Clergy Appreciation Month. In Timothy 1: 5-17, Paul began the concept of clergy appreciation when he stated that the elders of the church are worthy of a double honor. He reiterated this idea in Thessalonians 1:5-13, when he stated that those who work hard among you should be held in the highest regard for their work. This idea became Clergy Appreciation Month in 1992, established by priests, pastors and religious workers.

Please take the time to tell Fr. Ananias how much you appreciate him for all he has done for you, and for our Church. We appreciate you and we thank you Father for all your hard work, time, patience and love towards all of us...your “flock.”

***THE PERFECT PRIEST:***
