**St. Vincent College tops in graduation rates** – St. Vincent College, located in Westmoreland County, is ranked among the nation's best in terms of six year graduation rates, according to a New York Times study published in May. Reporters analyzed data from 368 colleges nationwide, using factors including student population income, race, gender, age and test scores – as well as transfer student achievement – to create an expected graduation rate for each school. Using that formula, St. Vincent out-performed its expected rate by 14 percentage points. St. Vincent College officials said only two other private colleges performed better nationwide.
