### **FEAST DAYS OF ST. MONICA & ST. AUGUSTINE**

This month we celebrate the feast days of two Saints who can be understood by anyone who has ever hoped that children will grow in sanctity as they head off on adventures which leave their parents a little bit unsure of what will come of it all.
