**SILVER CHALICES TO BE RE-PLATED**

Queen of Peace Parish is privileged to have a number of beautiful chalices for use in the Sacred Liturgy. Three of these are Silver and have reached the point of looking like pewter, as they are so tarnished and cannot be polished.

- † The St. Lawrence Chalice dates from 1854
- † The St. Boniface Chalice dates from 1866
- † A third Chalice found in the basement of the Rectory was last re-plated in 2012.

We are praying that the faithful from Saints Lawrence & Boniface would consider donations to help reduce the cost of re-plating, which is \$1,900 / per chalice! Any or all donations, no matter how large or small would be greatly appreciated. *God Bless You...*
