**MOST HOLY TRINITY** – *As we celebrate the mystery of the Trinity*, we also realize the mystery of how much God loves and cares for us each and every day. **REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL** – *On this the feast of the Most Holy Trinity*, we have one of the shortest Gospel readings of the year. The passage is only three verses and it is proclaimed at the eucharistic liturgy often in less than a minute, no more than two. The opening line of this Gospel reading will be familiar to many as it may be used frequently to sum up Christian theology: "*God so loved the world that He gave His only Son.*" This is a model for action motivated by love. We are to be givers, disciples of the Son of God Who was given to the world.

## ***THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI***

***Dearly Beloved in Christ,***

What a wonderful time to return to Church, the Feast of Our Lord's most precious Body and Blood. Denied the Wedding Banquet of the Lamb these past 14 weeks, prepare your hearts to receive Him.

- Confessions Saturdays at 4:00 PM., also **Wednesday, June 10<sup>th</sup> beginning at 6 PM** (with at least one other visiting priest present).
- Communion will be distributed *after* Masses.
- Masks are required however, for those not wearing them, we will presume *in charity*, that you have a pre-existing medical condition.
- The Mass schedule remains the same.
- Mass attendance is still optional. You remain dispensed of your obligation to be present.
- The number present is no longer 25 people, but is based rather on church capacity and social distancing.
- Family units are counted as 1 person.

## ***PROCESSION and BENEDICTION***

- Masses are permitted out – of – doors. We will *not* be doing that. However, since outdoors is an option, we will have a Procession (*properly social distanced*) with the Blessed Sacrament. This will take place at the conclusion of the Latin Mass (approx. 12:30). The Procession will conclude with Benediction.
