### **Memorial of the Passion of Saint John the Baptist August 29, 2020**

St. John the Baptist was truly the forerunner of the Messiah. Always one step ahead of Jesus' ministry. John was born first, began his ministry first, and died a martyr's death first. And it was clear that Jesus loved him, being deeply grieved when He heard the news of his beheading at the hand of King Herod. (Mt 14:1-12).

Jesus praised John the Baptist highly by saying, "Truly I tell you, among those born of women no one has arisen greater than John the Baptist."

One of the most highly venerated Saints, John the Baptist has two Feast Days: his *Nativity* on June 24 and his *Passion* on August 29.
