




Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 18, 2020

Luke the Evangelist is one of the Four Evangelists – the four traditionally ascribed authors of the Canonical Gospels. The Early Church Fathers ascribed to him authorship of both the *Gospel of Luke* and the *Acts of the Apostles*, which would mean Luke contributed over a quarter of the text of the New Testament, more than any other author. The New Testament mentions Luke briefly a few times, and the Pauline Epistle to the Colossians (Col. 4:14) refers to him as a physician (from Greek for ‘one who heals’); thus, he is thought to have been both a physician and a disciple of Paul. Since the early years of faith, Christians have regarded him as a *Saint*. He is believed to have been a martyr, reportedly having been hanged from an olive tree, though some believe otherwise. The Roman Catholic Church and other major denominations venerate him as Saint Luke the Evangelist, and as a patron Saint of artists, physicians, bachelors, surgeons, students and butchers; **his Feast Day is October 18.** Luke died at age 84 in Boeotia, according to a “fairly early and widespread tradition”. According to Nikephoros Kallistos Xanthopoulos, Greek historian of the 14th century (and others), Luke’s tomb was located in Thebes, whence his relics were transferred to Constantinople in the year 357.

**A BRIEF CATECHISM FOR CATHOLIC VOTERS by Fr. Stephen F. Torraco, Ph.D.**

**If I have strong feelings or opinions in favor of a particular candidate, even if he is pro-abortion, why may I not vote for him?** As explained in the first question, neither your feelings nor your opinions are identical with your conscience. Neither your feelings nor your opinions can take the place of your conscience. Your feelings and opinions should be *governed* by your conscience. If the candidate about whom you have strong favorable feelings or opinions promotes abortion, then your feelings and opinions need to be corrected by your correctly informed conscience, which would tell you that it is wrong for you to allow your feelings and opinions to give lesser weight to the fact that the candidate supports a moral evil.
