Announcement from Bishop Bartchak – Bishop Bartchak wishes to advise the faithful of the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown that John Tokarick, Jr. may be in the area (Cambria County) this summer, especially during the July 4th holiday, where he is inviting people to attend worship services in Prince Gallitzin State Park or elsewhere. After consultation with officials from the Byzantine Catholic Metropolitan Archeparchy of Pittsburgh and the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of St. Josaphat in Parma, it has been determined that John Tokarick, Jr. is **NOT A CATHOLIC PRIEST** and he is not permitted to function as a priest in the Catholic Church. You should not receive the sacraments from Tokarick or attend any of his liturgical services, wherever they may be held. **THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST** – July 1 is the Feast of the Most Precious Blood in the Traditional Liturgical Calendar. This Feast was instituted only in 1849, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the Sacraments were brought forth through His Blood. The special beauty of this Feast is its centering of our attention directly on the Blood of Christ, a short cut to the heart of revelation. The Blood of Christ purchased our salvation and pleads for us before the throne of God, yet it is the little fundamental, sane approach to God. It is hard and painful; it will help us to steel our own hearts against weakness. **His Blood redeems us.** There was a price against us that we could not pay, but the Blood of Jesus redeemed us. First Peter 1:18-19 says, "For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the Precious Blood of Christ, a Lamb without blemish or defect." **His Blood brings us into fellowship with God.** According to Ephesians 2:13, "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the Blood of Christ." Without the Blood of Christ, man is a long way from God. **His Blood makes peace with God.** Man, by nature, is at war with God; and we can only come to God on His peace terms – the Blood atonement. The Bible says in Colossians 1:20, "And, having made peace through the Blood of His Cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself..." **His Blood cleanses.** Not only does it remove the punishment of sin, it removes the pollution. I don't care what sin you've committed; "the Blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin (1 John 1:7). **His Blood gives power over the devil.** It's the Blood that Satan fears. Revelation 12:11 says, "And they overcame him (Satan) by the Blood of the Lamb..." The devil doesn't want you to learn about the Blood. He hates it!
