**St. John the Baptist, Summerhill is hosting a Parish Mission – Sunday, September 26 – Tuesday, September 28**, beginning at 7 PM each night. The theme for the Mission is Believe! **Sunday:** Greatest Threat to Holiness Today; **Monday:** Forgiveness; **Tuesday:** St. Joseph Model of Holiness. Confessions and Rosary each night beginning at 6:30 PM. Fr. Joseph Tuscan, OFM Cap will be speaker. He was born in Columbus, OH in 1967. He earned his Bachelor's degree in 1989 from Borromeo College Seminary. In 1990, he professed his first vows as a Capuchin Franciscan friar. Making his Perpetual vows in 1993, earned his Master's degree in theology in 1995 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1997. Fr. Joseph's first assignment after ordination was in Papua New Guinea in the South Pacific where he served for four years. Returning to the U.S. in 2001, he has served in various capacities as parochial vicar, pastor, military and hospital chaplain, and also served in Puerto Rico. Fr. Joseph currently serves as the national director of the Archconfraternity of Christian Mothers and in full-time preaching ministry for the Capuchin Province of St. Augustine, offering retreats and reflection days for parishes, Religious and Priests.

THE MOST HOLY NAME OF MARY

"The name of Mary," says Saint Anthony of Padua, "is sweeter to the lips than the honeycomb, more delightful to the ear than a sweet song, more entrancing to the heart than the purest joy." "Surely," says Saint Bernard, "the Mother of God could not have a name more appropriate, nor one more impressive of Her high dignity. Mary is in fact the beautiful and brilliant star which shines upon the vast and stormy sea of the world."

But, above all these interpretations, Mary's Name will ever signify all that is Holy and Blessed for "when the daughters of Zion saw Her, they cried out that She was Most Blessed, saying: 'Thy name is as ointment poured forth.'"

How we should honor this Holy Name of Mary; we should always invoke Father God, the Son of God, and the Holy Spirit, through His name. Tenderly must Jesus have spoken the name of His Mother. How His Sacred Heart was moved when He was called the Son of Mary.
