**SAINTS, SOULS AND SOLDIERS (PEACE-KEEPERS)**

The month of November comes so quickly after October that we hardly have a chance to clear out the cobwebs from our lives and realize that Hallowe'en has come and gone and the world has remarkably passed over the Feast of ALL SAINTS and the *COMMÉMORATION OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED*. We do get a break, though, when we come to REMEMBRANCE DAY on November 11th, (although our society certainly only gives that lip service, and not a celebration).

I think we as a Catholic Christian people have a responsibility and a need to celebrate all three...SAINTS, SOULS AND SOLDIERS!
