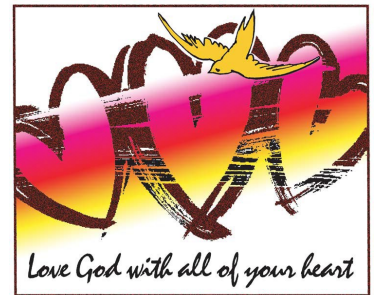

**Pastor's Note:**

**SAINTS, SOULS AND SOLDIERS (PEACE-KEEPERS)**

The month of November comes so quickly after October that we hardly have a chance to clear out the cobwebs from our lives and realize that Hallowe'en has come and gone and the world has remarkably passed over the Feast of ALL SAINTS and the COMMEMORATION OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED. We do get a break, though, when we come to REMEMBRANCE DAY on November 11th, (although our society certainly only gives that lip service, and not a celebration).

I think we as a Catholic Christian people have a responsibility and a need to celebrate all three...SAINTS, SOULS AND SOLDIERS! We need to be reminded about the depth of what is before us; we must be cognizant of the Communion of Saints, those saints in heaven, those who are on the path to heaven and are expiating their sins in Purgatory, and we the saints on earth who are on their pilgrim way to heaven. It is through OUR good works that those in Purgatory will move on to heaven. This is a truly remarkable bond of Heaven, Purgatory and Earth.

There is also a remarkable bond between those who have sacrificed their lives and/or their health in waging peace for those left behind in the many wars and conflicts of the past. There are the Canadian Forces who we remember; there are, also, the men and women of the armed forces of the many countries that are represented within our parish family who answered the call from their home countries to serve. By remembering we do not glorify war; we glorify the sacrifices that the many men and women made so that others could be free.

We also remember when we say SOLDIERS, the men and women of the Canadian Forces who work as peacekeepers in the many trouble spots of the world under the auspices of the United Nations. Canadian forces serve in Kosovo, in Haiti and Cyprus and in Eastern Europe.

***November is a good time of year; we remember; let us never forget!!***
