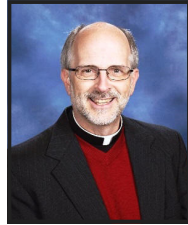

**Ken's Kaleidoscope**

October 14, 2018



Next week is World Mission Sunday. We remember the revitalizing mission which is the heart of our Christian faith—to bring the Gospel to all! The collection ensures the work of our Missionary Church by supporting priests, religious, and lay leaders who offer the Lord's mercy and concrete help to vulnerable communities. Thank you for your generosity.

At its recent meeting, the Parish Council approved a parish policy to guide the distribution of funds in a newly created Charitable Giving Fund. This year the budget designates 2% of our Sunday giving to be placed in a fund to make charitable contributions for agencies and special needs in the name of our parish. Larger gifts will be made to our sister parish in El Sitio, and our sister Diocese of Lodwar. Other contributions will go to local agencies like Open Doors (housing), the Gospel Mission, Loaves and Fishes, and Ministry with Community (the hungry and homeless), Right to Life, and Clean Water for the World. We will inform you periodically how that money is being distributed. Most recently a gift was made to St. Catherine of Siena Parish in Pondo, Kenya, for helping to put tile flooring in their new church.

A columbarium is a structure for the permanent storage of the ashes of deceased loved ones. The parish is going to consider whether to construct a columbarium on church property. I creating a small *ad hoc committee* to create a business plan for submission and consideration by the parish staff and the parish council. Reflections on Personal Holiness by Pope Francis (3)

Pope Francis repeats that the Lord directs the call to holiness personally to each of us: "Be holy, for I am holy." (Leviticus 11:44; cf. 1 Peter 1:16) A document from Vatican Council II stated this clearly: "... all the faithful, whatever their condition or state, are called by the Lord – each in his or her own way – to that perfect holiness by which the Father himself is perfect." He underlines that we each do it in our own way, and do not simply copy someone else's behavior. He doesn't want us to be become discouraged that we're unable to do what someone else did; in fact, that could be a mistake and we would miss out on what "the Lord has in mind for us." We have to figure out our own path, using the very best of ourselves, and the particular gifts God has given to us personally. (1 Corinthians 12:7) (para. 6, 7 in *Gaudete et Exsultate*) **What are some ways of holiness that are particularly your own.? Don't be shy!**
