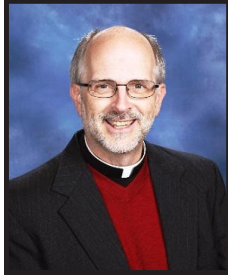

Reflections on Personal Holiness by Pope Francis (18)

Pope Francis says that to avoid pelagianism we need to focus on the center, which is always love. "For the whole law is summed up in a single commandment, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'" (Galatians 5:14) Amid all the rules and guidelines, he says, "Jesus clears a way to seeing two faces, that of the Father and that of our brother [and sister]. He does not give us two more formulas or two more commands. He gives us two faces, or better yet, one alone: the face of God reflected in so many other faces. For in every one of our brothers and sisters, especially the least, the most vulnerable, the defenseless, and those in need, God's very image is found.
