Become a Greeter or an Usher

What are the responsibilities of a Greeter or an Usher?

Greeters and Ushers are essential for making our Parishioners feel welcome while also ensuring everyone follows our church's protocols for protecting one another during the COVID-19 pandemic. Greeters stand by the main doors in the Narthex and provide a welcoming wave and friendly greeting, while also helping us keep count of how many Parishioners come in the building. Ushers help Parishioners find their seats at a safe distance apart from other families and dismiss individual rows of Parishioners at Communion and at the end of Mass to ensure safe social distancing. Greeting and Ushering can also be a great family activity! Contact us today to learn more how your family can help.

How often would I have to volunteer?

You can volunteer as often as your schedule allows. Some of our Greeters and Ushers like to volunteer bi-weekly or monthly. You can volunteer as often as it fits your schedule. For Ushers, we do all scheduling online and you will receive reminders when your scheduled date is coming up. You can always request a "sub" for the days you cannot volunteer. For Greeters, we have a SignUp Genius run by a volunteer Parishioner who will help you get set up with the website. You can sign up as you are able to volunteer.
