| L   | <b>Adult Faith Formation</b>      | Encounter Jesus Christ through Bible Study, retreats and fellowship opportunities.  | L   | <b>Elizabeth Ministry</b>                       | Provides opportunities for prayers for those who are trying to conceive a child, awaiting adoption, or have experienced a pregnancy loss.   |
| L V | <b>Altar Server</b>               | Assistant to the priests and deacons during the celebration of the Eucharist.   | L   | <b>Eucharistic Adoration</b>                    | Faithfully praying to Jesus, who is present in the Eucharist.   |
| L V | <b>Art &amp; Environment</b>      | Church decorating team who decorate according to the liturgical seasons and special celebrations.   | L V | <b>Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion</b> | Distribute the Body and Blood of Christ to fellow parishioners at Mass.   |
| L   | <b>Benedictine Oblates</b>        | Group who focus on living in the presence of God and doing the will of God.   | L   | <b>Faith in Action Together (FIAT)</b>          | Group who learn more about their faith and build strong fellowship among members to feel more comfortable sharing their faith.  |
| L V | <b>Bulletin Assistant</b>         | Volunteer who enters the Mass schedule into the bulletin each week.   | L V | <b>Finance Council</b>                          | Volunteer Parishioners who advise the Pastor in forming good policies for the administration of the parish's temporal good.   |
| L V | <b>Catechist</b>                  | Volunteer teachers who teach the principles of Christian religion for Children's Faith Formation.   | L V | <b>Funeral Luncheons</b>                        | Volunteers who provide and serve lunches for funerals at no cost to the families. Some volunteers provide dishes to pass at the meal.   |
| L V | <b>Catholic Men's Fellowship</b>  | Group of men who discuss scripture and/or Catholic books to become better Catholic men.   | L   | <b>Golf League</b>                              | During golf season, opportunity for Parishioners to join leagues that meet at Pineview Golf Course: couples league meets on Monday evenings and a men's league meets on Wednesday evenings. |
| L   | <b>Children's Faith Formation</b> | Guides children in their faith journey and to assist parents as the primary educator of their children.                                       | L V | <b>Greeter</b>                                  | Volunteers who provide a friendly, welcoming presence and greets new and current members before each weekend mass.  |
| L V | <b>Coffee &amp; Donuts</b>        | Volunteers who prepare coffee and donuts from August - April for parishioners after Sunday morning Masses to create fellowship opportunities. | L   | <b>Grief Support</b>                            | Grief program that provides emotional and spiritual support to those who are grieving the death of a loved one.   |
| L V | <b>Collection Counter</b>         | Volunteers who assist with counting Sunday and/or Holy day collections.   | L V | <b>High School Faith Formation</b>              | Program that teaches and inspires High School students to engage with God.  |
| L   | <b>Divorce Ministry</b>           | Program that provides support for those who have gone through or are going through a divorce.   | L V | <b>Hospitality &amp; Welcome Committees</b>     | Groups that serves the parish by providing social events and receptions as needed.  |

| <b>L</b>   | <b>Intercessory Prayers</b>                  | Parishioners who pray the Rosary after daily Mass on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel.  | <b>L V</b> | <b>Prayer Line</b>           | Parishioners who provide confidential prayer support for anyone wanting or needing additional prayers.  |
| <b>L V</b> | <b>Lector</b>                                | Proclaim the Word of God at Mass and other liturgical services.  | <b>L V</b> | <b>Sacristan</b>             | Parishioners who come early to set up for Mass and make sure there are a sufficient number of liturgical ministers present. After Mass, they clean the vessels and collect the linens for the laundry, and put things away. |
| <b>L V</b> | <b>Linen Guild</b>                           | Parishioners who make sure that we have clean, fresh altar linens and purificators for each Mass.  | <b>L V</b> | <b>Soundboard for Mass</b>   | Volunteers who monitor the soundboard during weekend Mass. May include monitoring the lights, music, running slides, or videos. Training is provided.   |
| <b>L V</b> | <b>Maintenance (Buildings &amp; Grounds)</b> | Volunteers who help maintain the church building with minor repairs, cleaning and maintenance. General ground upkeep such as mowing, weeding, or winter care.                  | <b>L V</b> | <b>Usher</b>                 | Parishioners who welcome people to our parish, hand out worship aids, help people find their seats, take up the collections and put them away for safekeeping. Must be at least 10 years old to be an Usher.                |
| <b>L V</b> | <b>Middle School Faith Formation</b>         | Program that teaches and inspires Middle School students to engage with God.   | <b>L V</b> | <b>Vacation Bible School</b> | Yearly ministry outreach program for children in grades K-5 to educate children about God.  |
| <b>L V</b> | <b>Ministers to the Sick</b>                 | Distribute Communion to the sick and homebound of the parish who are unable to participate the Eucharist at Mass.  | <b>L</b>   | <b>Widow &amp; Widowers</b>  | Network of support to those who have lost their spouse.   |
| <b>L</b>   | <b>MOPS (Moms of Preschoolers)</b>           | Mom's Group for Mothers with children from pregnancy to Kindergarten. Childcare is available.  | <b>L</b>   | <b>Women of the Word</b>     | Group of women seeking a deeper relationship with Christ through book studies and fellowship.   |
| <b>L V</b> | <b>Music</b>                                 | Our Music Ministry offers many opportunities to get involved in music: Cantor, choir, Gathering Band, The Sienas, Upper Harmony Children's Choir, and Young Adult Praise Band. |            |                              |   |
| <b>L V</b> | <b>Plant Ministry</b>                        | Parishioners who water, prune, and care for the plants throughout the church and the rest of the church facilities.  |            |                              |   |
