Adult Faith Formation	Encounter Jesus Christ through Bible Study, retreats and fellowship opportunities.	Varies
Altar Server	Assistant to the priests and deacons during the celebration of Mass.	1.5 hours per mass
Art & Environment	Church decorating team who decorate according to the liturgical seasons and special celebrations.	Varies; 2-3 hours when liturgical year changes six times a year
Benedictine Oblates	Group who focus on living in the presence of God and doing the will of God.	
Bulletin Assistant	Volunteer who enters the Mass schedule into the bulletin each week.	1-2 hours a month
Catechist	Volunteer teachers who teach the principles of Christian religion for Children's Faith Formation.	1.5 hours for one day a week, September - Easter
Catholic Men's Fellowship	Group of men who discuss scripture and/or Catholic books to become better Catholic men.	1 hour every Saturday morning
Coffee & Donuts	Volunteers who prepare coffee and donuts from August - April for parishioners after Sunday morning Masses to create fellowship opportunities.	3-4 hours on occasional Sundays
Collection Counter	Volunteers who assist with counting Sunday and/or Holy day collections.	Currently have enough volunteers, but are always looking for substitutes. Time is as needed, 1.5 hours on Mondays.
Eucharistic Adoration	Faithfully praying to Jesus, who is present in the Eucharist.	1 hour per week
Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion	Distribute the Body and Blood of Christ to fellow parishioners at Mass.	1.25 hours per mass
Funeral Luncheons	<i>Volunteers who serve and prepare the setup and clean-up of funeral lunches and/or provide side dishes or desserts.</i>	<i>Coming back in 2022</i>
Golf League	During golf season, opportunity for Parishioners to join leagues that meet at Pineview Golf Course: couples league meets on Monday evenings and a men's league meets on Wednesday evenings.	Roughly 3 hours of golf, social time afterwards if desired
Greeter	Volunteers who provide a friendly and welcoming presence. The volunteer greets new and current members before a weekend Mass.	30 minutes before Mass
Grief Support	<i>Grief program that provides emotional and spiritual support to those who are grieving the death of a loved one.</i>	<i>Inactive through the end of 2021</i>
High School Faith Formation	Program that teaches and inspires High School students to engage with God.	1.5 hours per session
Hospitality & Welcome Committees	Groups that serves the parish by providing social events and receptions as needed.	Varies
Knights of Columbus	Catholic Men's Fraternal Organization. The key principles are Charity, Unity, Fraternity, and Patriotism. Worldwide, there are approximately 1.8 million members and there are over 15,000 councils.	Varies
Lector	Proclaim the Word of God at Mass and other liturgical services.	1.25 hours per mass
Linen Guild	Parishioners who make sure that we have clean, fresh altar linens and purificators for each Mass.	One month a year during the year - usually takes two hours per week
Middle School Faith Formation	Program that teaches and inspires Middle School students to engage with God.	1.5 hours per session
Ministers to the Sick	<i>Distribute Communion to the sick and homebound of the parish who are unable to participate the Eucharist at Mass.</i>	<i>Inactive due to COVID</i>

MOPS (Moms of Preschoolers)	Mom's Group for Mothers with children from pregnancy to Kindergarten. <i>Childcare currently unavailable due to COVID.</i>	2 hour meetings every other week from September - May. Occasional Mom's Night Out, Playdates, or Service events that are optional.
Music	Our Music Ministry offers many opportunities to get involved in music: Cantor, choir, Gathering Band, The Sienas, Upper Harmony Children's Choir, and Young Adult Praise Band.	Varies
Plant Ministry	Parishioners who water, prune, and care for the plants throughout the church and the rest of the church facilities.	One hour per week
Prayer Line	Parishioners who provide confidential prayer support for anyone wanting or needing additional prayers.	Varies
Prayer Shawl Weavers	Prayer Shawl Weavers create special, hand-knit shawls for Parishioners in need. Each shawl is prayed over before working on the shawl and after it is finished. When completed, the shawl is blessed by a priest and then given to a Parishioner or individual experiencing a particularly difficult time and in need of prayer.	Varies
Primitimers	Prime-timers is a group of men and women 50 years of age or older. This is a group of people coming together for fellowship. Our group meets for lunch on the first Monday of each month at 11:30.	First Monday of the month at 11:30 am. Times and location vary.
Respect Life/ Walking with Moms in Need	The St Catherine's Respect Life Ministry recognizes the dignity of each individual as created in the image and likeness of God and seeks through faith, hope, and love, to protect and promote the sanctity of God's children from the moment of conception to natural death through prayer, education, and outreach.	Varies
Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)	The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, or RCIA , is a communal process for formal initiation into the Catholic Church. We welcome all who are interested in learning more about the Catholic Church to join us in RCIA!	Weekly; Usually September - Easter
Sacristan	Parishioners who come early to set up for Mass and make sure there are a sufficient number of liturgical ministers present. After Mass, they clean the vessels and collect the linens for the laundry, and put things away.	1.75 hours per mass
Soundboard for Mass	Volunteers who monitor the soundboard during weekend Mass. May include monitoring the lights, music, running slides, or videos. Training is provided.	1.5 hours per Mass
St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP)	SVDP exists for all adults interested in helping the poor and in developing their own spirituality to see Christ in those we serve. We started at St. Catherine of Siena Parish in the early 1970s.	Varies
Usher	Parishioners who welcome people to our parish, hand out worship aids, help people find their seats, take up the collections and put them away for safekeeping. Must be at least 10 years old to be an Usher alone. Families are always welcome to Usher together!	1.5 Hour per Mass
Vacation Bible School	Yearly ministry outreach program for children in grades K-5 to educate children about God.	Varies
Women of the Word	Group of women seeking a deeper relationship with Christ through book studies and fellowship.	2 hours every Thursday or Sunday from September - December or January - May.
