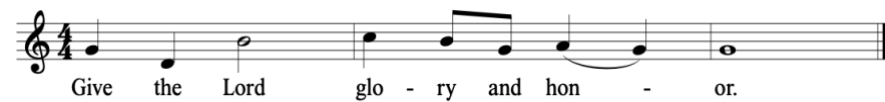
### READING I

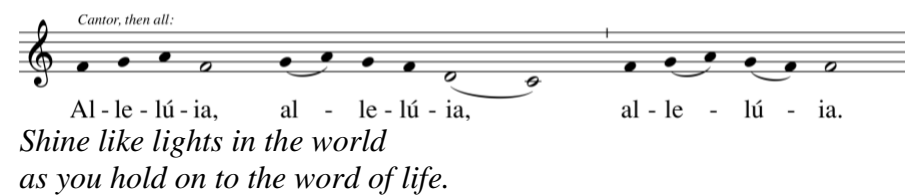
