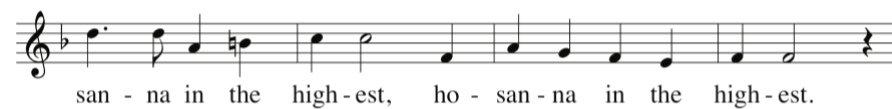

### GOSPEL

Matthew 25:31-46

Jesus said to his disciples:

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory,
