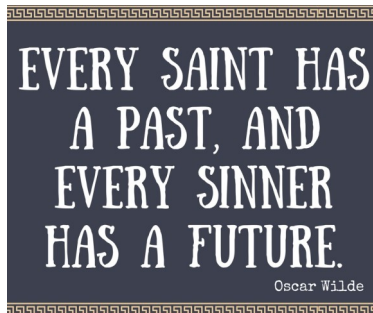

## WOMEN'S CENTER

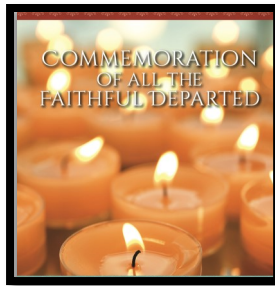
