**God is Good all the time!

Today we celebrate **the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ** known as the feast of **Corpus Christi**.

Let us be grateful of this great sacrament- the **sacrament of the Eucharist** that we celebrate every Sunday where we can receive the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**.

As human beings, we need real food to feed our bodies. As spiritual beings we also need spiritual food to feed our souls. **For us as Catholics**, the Eucharist is the most important sacrament as the **Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC)** says:

CCC 1324: *“The Eucharist is **“the source and summit of the Christian life.”** The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch.”*

CCC 1326: *“Finally, by the Eucharistic celebration we already unite ourselves with the heavenly liturgy and anticipated eternal life, when God will be all in all.”*

CCC 1335: *“The miracles of the multiplication of the loaves, when the Lord says the blessing, breaks and distributes the loaves through his disciples to feed the multitude, prefigure the superabundance of this unique bread of his Eucharist. The sign of water turned into wine at Cana already announces the Hour of Jesus' glorification. It makes manifest the fulfillment of the wedding feast in the Father's kingdom, where the faithful will drink the new wine that has become the Blood of Christ. There is power in the Eucharist. There is life, love, nourishment, and refreshment, in the Body and Blood of Christ.*

So, let's be grateful and let us always celebrate this great sacrament with faith, love and reverence.

Funerals:

Please contact the parish office **BEFORE** finalizing any arrangements with a funeral home.

Baptism:

Parents must be registered members of Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church or another Catholic Parish for at least six months. Godparents **MUST** be confirmed Catholics. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class prior to the baptism. Call the office for more information.

Marriage:


The rules of the Diocese require at least a 6-month marriage preparation period prior to a wedding. Contact the church office **BEFORE** making any arrangements and to receive complete instructions.
