

God is Good all the time! And all the time God is Good.



Today we celebrate the **Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**.

In today's Gospel (Mark 6:1-6), we learn that Jesus went back to his hometown, Nazareth. However, Jesus was rejected by his own people, and He was not able to perform a lot of miracles there because of people's lack of faith. Jesus only cured a few sick people who have faith by laying hands on them. Jesus was amazed at their lack of faith.

#### Jealousy.

One of the reasons why people rejected Jesus in his hometown is **jealousy**. They said, "Where did this man get all this? What kind of wisdom has been given him? What mighty deeds are wrought by his hands! Is he not the carpenter, the son of Mary, and the brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? And are not his sisters here with us? And they took offense at him. Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house."

**Jealousy** is a very dangerous virus for our spiritual life. Because it can poison our thoughts, blind our eyes to see good things of others as wrong things.

#### Faith

Faith is **the key** to unlock our blessings. **If we** want to receive God's blessings, miracles, and healing in our lives, we need to put our faith and trust in Jesus. Why can Jesus not do anything without our faith? It is not because Jesus is powerless without our faith. Rather, the power of Jesus only works effectively for the people who have faith.

#### **Registered Parishioners:**

Registered parishioners are those who have submitted a form to the parish office and use parish support envelopes consistently.

Please contact the parish office **BEFORE** finalizing any arrangements with a funeral home.

# **Baptism:**

Parents must be registered members of Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church or another Catholic Parish for at least six months. Godparents MUST be confirmed Catholics. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class prior to the baptism. Call the office for more information.

#### Marriage:

The rules of the Diocese require at least a 6-month marriage preparation period prior to a wedding. Contact the church office **BEFORE** making any arrangements and to receive complete instructions.


