NATIONAL DONOR SABBATH

National Donor Sabbath is observed annually two weekends before **Thanksgiving, from Friday through Sunday**. This three-day observance seeks to include the days of worship for major religions practiced in the United States. During **National Donor Sabbath**, faith leaders from many religions, donor families, transplant recipients, and donation and transplantation professionals *educate the public about the need* for the lifesaving and healing gifts passed to others through transplantation, while also *encouraging people to register their decision* to be organ, eye and tissue donors.

One of the biggest misconceptions about organ donation is that your religious beliefs could stop you from becoming an organ donor. For the millions of Catholics and Christians around the world, **Pope Francis** put that fear to bed permanently. According to **Pope Francis**, “a gift to the suffering Lord who said that everything we have done for a brother or sister in need we have done for him.”

Baptism:

Parents must be registered members of Our Lady Star of the Sea Catholic Church or another Catholic Parish for at least six months. Godparents **MUST** be confirmed Catholics. Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptismal Prep Class prior to the baptism. Call the office for more information.

Marriage:


The rules of the Diocese require at least a 6-month marriage preparation period prior to a wedding. Contact the church office **BEFORE** making any arrangements and to receive complete instructions.
