

CARDINAL FOLEY REOPENING PLAN

This plan is not complete but it is what we know as of July 13. As the guidance changes, we will update our plan and notify you through Option C.

SCREENING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Daily symptom screening will be conducted each day. The procedure for this is still being explored.
MASKING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every student from PS to grade 8 will be required to have a mask with them each day. The mask is to be stored in a brown paper bag to prevent moisture build up. Families will provide the mask and we ask that the masks are a solid color – gray, maroon, blue, black, white. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All children need to be masked when entering the school and when leaving the building. ➤ Times when masks will be required are still in discussion stage. ➤ Gator masks are an acceptable choice. ➤ There will be mask breaks. ➤ Teachers and staff will wear face shields and /or masks.
SOCIAL DISTANCING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Desks will be at a minimum of 3 feet apart in Grades 1 to 8 classrooms. • PS, PK and K classroom set up is still in discussion.
HYGIENE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sanitizers are being installed in each classroom. Each time a student enters a classroom, he/she will be required to use the sanitizer. Parents are asked to provide individual hand lotion for the students to use on a daily basis. • Since community supplies will not be available, each student in grades K to 8 will need a box to store his/her supplies. Target sells a box that is made by Sterilite that is the perfect size for storage in the classroom. It is a clear plastic shoebox size container. • Please refer to the individual grade stationery list for supplies that are needed to begin school. • Bathroom breaks will be scheduled in the morning and after lunch. Students will be required to wash their hands with soap and water during these times. • Water fountains will be turned off. Each student needs to bring a filled water bottle to school each day.
