- Principal's Report

The beginning of the school year seems to be going well. Enrollment is better than what it was in June. It has continued to fluctuate. We currently have 235 students.

There have been some faculty and staff changes including Alex Galli, Kindergarten, Lisa Buffone, Preschool, Frank Saba, Middle School Advisor, and Erin McLoughlin, Second Grade. All the new staff members have acclimated nicely to their new roles.

Technology is evolving at St. Mary School. The school purchased 50 new Chrome books for student use. The Chrome books are up and running. There are also a couple of computers and Chrome books that are stationed in the Library for after school use.

The bullying policy has been updated and on the website. Staff will have mandatory training in October. Parents and students will also have training through the District Attorney's office in October.

A committee met over the summer to review and update the schools By-Laws. School Board members are asked to review the By-Laws for approval at the next meeting on November 15, 2016.

The new Mission Statement was introduced to each class. At Mass on Wednesday (9/7), a representative from each class and the homeroom teacher came forward with their classes' Mission Statement and it was blessed by Msgr. Mike. There is also a new spirit wear that can be purchased to promote school spirit.

The pancake breakfast was a success. The community was very supportive by providing supplies for the event. The eighth grade class earned a good sum of money to apply towards their trip to Washington, DC.

- Financial Overview

The committee met over the summer to review the budget because of the reduction in enrollment. The school is currently using a working budget. There was a budget that would not work based on the current enrollment so the working plan was developed. The working budget will allow the school to remain in good standing without a deficit at the end of the year. Last year's budget will be reviewed and finalized this week. Last year's budget ended with a surplus.

The finance committee meets frequently. They review the budget, set the budget for the following year and also make a recommendation for the following year's tuition increase.

- Curriculum Overview

The curriculum committee has not met since the last School Board Meeting. Roseanne has requested that someone take her place as the chair for the Curriculum Committee. Arlena Boyle has offered to become the Curriculum Committee Chair.

A suggestion was made to add a technology component to the committee rather than having a separate committee for technology especially because technology should be ingrained in all of the curriculum areas. The board agreed that Gabriel Beltran should sit on this committee as the faculty representative. Another suggestion for the committee was to review the Khan Academy online resources.

The curriculum committee meets about 5 times a year and discusses matters relating to curriculum development. They may also find information relating to new programs or programs that other schools in the area are currently using.

- Advancement Overview

The Advancement Committee has not met since the last School Board meeting.

This committee gathers funds that can be used for school purposes as well as for the Endowment. Members elicit funds from alumni, parents, grandparents and supporters of the school. This committee also assists in providing faculty with items from their wish list. The committee usually meets about 5 times a year.

The enrollment committee meets approximately 5 times a year. They often meet with the Marketing Committee as the two committees work so closely with one
