We have continued talking with the children about how each person is special in his/her own way. This week we talked about all of our special talents. We are currently working on rhyming, letter/sound recognition and identifying number to item correspondence. Extra reinforcement at home with these skills would be beneficial.

Here are a few highlights from our week:

- Share their own special talent with the class
- Identify picture/number connection by playing “Roll, Count, Write”
- Listen to The Magic Hat
- Differentiate between beginning and ending sounds
- Identify their growth and development from infancy
- Identify basic shapes
- Read pre-decodable *I Can* and illustrate something that they can do
- Practice rhyming
- Identify beginning and ending parts of the story
- Practice correct formation of numbers
- Create a family portrait
