- Practice sequencing numbers
- Review high frequency words (we have learned 17 so far)

- Reinforce addition by playing the game Snowball with a partner
- Associate particular events with a particular season in his/her Seasons booklet
- Create a class graph about our favorite season- Summer was the winner
- Identify elements of narratives: who, where, what
- Listen to The Mitten and The Hat by Jan Brett
- Sequence characters from the story
- Practice continuing patterns
- Identify characters from the story and match it to a sentence about that character
- Compare lengths of objects
