- Practice phonemic awareness using Splash into Phonics
- Identify beginning and ending sounds
- Identify opposites
- Listen to Alice and Greta, The Wrong Way Rabbit and Orla's Upside Down Day
- Learn facts about lions and lambs
- Practice using number bonds to solve subtraction problems
- Demonstrate story sequence of the story Anna's Secret Friend
- Read decodable books "What Will Dad See?" and "Where will Max Sit?"
- Play sight word games
- Write -op and -ot word families
- Reinforce estimating and graphing of happy/sad smiley faces
