We have had a wonderful week in Kindergarten. The children have been reviewing high frequency words, writing sentences and practicing addition. Having children practice their high frequency words and writing sentences at home including: beginning a sentence with a capital, appropriate finger spacing and using punctuation is always helpful.

Here are a few highlights from our week:

- Listen to Chugga, Chugga Choo, Choo
- Reinforce number, domino correspondence
- Sequence a story in order
- Practice phonemic awareness using Splash into Phonics
- Identify beginning and ending sounds
- Listen to I'm a Jolly Farmer, David's Drawings, My Crayons Talk and All You Need for a Snowman
- Practice sight words using the game "Spill and Spell"
- Respond to literature by illustrating something that they like to play
- Write words by identifying beginning, middle and ending sounds
- Practice new sight words *one, see, what* and *two*
- Write numbers 1-31
- Practice working with tens and ones
- Read the decodable *What Can Two Do?*
- Practice addition
- Write sight words in paint and put them in a sentence
